PROCEDURE TO USE UNI-SAFE FOR BIOLOGICAL AND CHEMICAL SPILLS

Purpose: To assure appropriate use and application of UNI-SAFE.

Procedure:

- 1. Wear proper protective equipment (gloves, gown, and mask).
- 2. Pour UNI-SAFE around and over the spill (This includes biological and/or chemical including oxidizers and reactives).
- 3. Wait until the spill solidifies into a gel. Stirring it in will expedite the absorption of the spilled chemical.
- 4. Use plastic scooper to pick up gel-like substance to place in a red biohazard bag/container.
- 5. For large quantity spill, call environmental services for assistance in cleanup.

Indicators:

Acids- yellow Alkalines- red

Note: UNI-SAFE does not neutralize, therefore, for formalin spills, use Spill XF-P and follow procedure. Store in a dry place

UNI-SAFE expires 5 years after the date noted on container.
