Deferral Slip: Providing Donor with Deferral Information

Purpose

Donors who are deferred during an attempt to donate blood or blood components are given the option to have the reason for deferral provided in writing.

Policy

- All donors who are deferred at the time of donation are given the option if they would like a written slip stating the reason for the deferral.
- The Kaiser Permanente Blood Donor (KP DC) staff will provide the Deferral slip to the donor with the information concerning the deferral.
- The donor will be given the opportunity to ask question about the deferral
- The KP DC staff will document informing the donor about the deferral on the DHQ/IDR (comment section) or/and in SafeTrace under memorandum or deferral memo.
