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HOW TO CHECK PATIENT'S RESTROOM ALARM

Purpose

To define the procedure in checking patient restroom alarm in the Clinical Laboratory.

Policy

On a monthly basis, the Clinical Laboratory must test patient alarm systems to ensure that all patient clinical alarms are activated with appropriate settings and are sufficiently audible in an emergency situation.

Procedure

The table below describes the steps to take in checking patient restroom alarms.

Step	Action				
1	Pull the string for the patient alarm located in the patient restroom.				
2	Go back to the reception area and check for audible alarm and a visual alarm (blinking light). • Visual alarm - blinking light • Audible alarm - must be audible enough to be heard in a typical laboratory activity.				
3	If	Then			
	No blinking light	Call Bio-med for repair or service.			
	Audible alarm is not loud enough or no sound at all	Call Bio-med for repair or service.			
	Visual and audible alarm are both acceptable	Record monitor as acceptable on the form			
4	To reset the alarm, press the reset button, located above the alarm switch in the patient restroom.				
5	Record monthly test as acceptable or not acceptable on the form - Patient's Restrooms Clinical Alarm Monthly Monitor.
