



# Lab Communication - Change to Inpatient/ED URINALYSIS WITH MICROSCOPIC Orders

Intended Audience: Inpatient & ED Providers, Nurses, Clinicians, and Laboratory Teams




**Summary:** If a Urinalysis order (LAB211180 or LAB1231026) is placed on an IP/ED patient, collecting users and lab staff will now see two distinct containers required for collection; UrYELLOW and UR GRY. This change is ONLY for admission encounter (inpatient) orders and not applicable to Ambulatory/Outpatient or External Requisition encounter orders. Ambulatory (OP)/Requisition orders will not require a Urine Gray tube to be collected.


# When ordering, the user will place the single lab order:

- ENTERPRISE (CHE, CHW, CHS): URINALYSIS WITH MICROSCOPIC LAB2111180
- CHE ONLY: CHE URINALYSIS WITH MICROSCOPIC IF IND LAB1231026


## When collecting, the user will see two orders to bring into collection:












**Note:** the test name shorthand on the label with vary depending on your region. UAC for CHE and UA for CHW/CHS. All regions will have "Urine GREY" for the grey container.


- For Providers, nurses, and collecting clinicians, see timestamps 0-2:30 for ordering and collecting.

  - Note for all watching the current state demo at timestamp 05:00-06:00: depending on your region, you
    may currently be receiving a different number of container IDs with your specimens. (CHW gets a .1,
    CHE/CHS get a .1/.2 with the hybrid container).

### Ordering a Urine Culture for Add On Testing

If the provider needs to place the order for a Urine Culture (LAB239), because the Urine Grey was collected and available in the laboratory, the urine culture order will now default to Use Existing Specimen and give the time the original specimen was collected.



When the add on order is submitted, Lab staff will receive this request in their Add On In Basket and can act on the add on accordingly.
