## SCPMG Laboratory System – Regional Reference Laboratories

Effective on 10-16-2017, all Candida isolates from Blood cultures, Sterile Site cultures and Fungal cultures from a sterile source will be tested for susceptibility to Fluconazole, Voriconazole, and Caspofungin in the Mycology laboratory at North Hollywood RRL. The interpretations are based on CLSI guidelines. MIC Interpretative Criteria (µg/ml)
