


NEW SMARTGROUP PANELS FOR FLOW CYTOMETRY WORKFLOWS

Effective August 7, 2017: Two new SmartGroup Panels were implemented for Blood and Cerebrospinal Fluid (CSF) Flow Cytometry workflows to improve ease in ordering and remind Lab accessioning team of requirement for specimen aliquots for both Pathology and Flow Lab. It is recommended that you order CSF and Blood Flow Cytometry as panels to ensure all tests are completed.


