Starting with CBC NO DIFFERENTIAL [85027A], a series of additional tests will automatically be performed and an interpretation will be rendered if anemia is detected:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AUTOMATED RETICULOCYTE COUNT AND OTHER CELLULAR PARAMETERS [85046] • CELL MORPHOLOGY SMEAR [85008E] • IRON [83540]; FERRITIN [82728]; and TOTAL IRON BINDING CAPACITY AND TRANSFERRIN SATURATION [83550] • VITAMIN B12 [COBALAMIN] [82607] • CREATININE, SERUM [82565] <p>This panel will initially be restricted only to orthopedic patients undergoing prosthetic joint replacement. Coagulation QC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Due to the increase in testing of covid patient there has been an increase usage of FIB, DD, XA, NEO, PTT reagent ALL QC have to be run at the stated times of 0400, 1200, 2000. Even if you had to run the QC on a new reagent because you ran out (for example running QC at 0300, 1030, 1850. It is not acceptable to not run the QC at the designated times this leads to tests being run without valid QC which is >8 hrs from the last run. 	CLS
