URGENT: NATIONAL SHORTAGE OF APTIMA CT/GC COLLECTION KITS

Due to a national shortage of Aptima Urine/Unisex collection kits, Hologic is unable to replenish the KP SCAL /NCAL regions with their full orders. Hologic, Vizient, and Kaiser national supply are closely monitoring and coordinating medical center inventories to provide the minimum number of kits needed for continued molecular chlamydia/gonorrhea testing. Unfortunately, there are no alternatives for the Urine vials at this time. However, Aptima Multi Test Swab (MTS) vials can be used as a replacement for the Unisex swab vials.

Rest assured we are in constant communication with Hologic and KP National Supply Chain to assist us in supplying our region with any inventory availability updates.
