#### SIMPLIFICATION OF PROCESSING FOR FOLATE SAMPLES

Effective immediately, serum collected for VITAMIN B9 [FOLIC ACID] [82746B] will no longer require transfer to an amber tube.

- Internal studies have confirmed that promptly placing and transporting samples in the blue racks provides sufficient light protection. The success of this change depends upon you to quickly move samples to the blue racks!
- Collection labels will change on December 16, 2020 to reflect consolidation with samples collected for other tests.
- This change will spare the patients' blood and the laboratory staff's sweat and tears.
