Assessment of Ungraded Coagulation PT Challenges

Purpose

This procedure provides assessment instructions for evaluating ungraded Coagulation proficiency testing challenges.

Scope

This procedure is intended for CLIA director and designee assessing proficiency testing challenges in the Coagulation discipline.

Policy

 For ungraded proficiency testing challenges, the laboratory CLIA director or designee will assess the submitted results when the evaluation report is received.

This includes the following survey mailing events:

- CGL
- CGS4
- CGE
- PIA

Evaluation

The following will be the criteria in assessing if a submitted result to the PT challenge is acceptable or not.

Note: An evaluation report does not warrant internal investigation when ungraded challenge result does not agree with the peer majority due to differences in reference ranges established by the various laboratories.
