POLICY GUIDELINES

A. Procedure

- 1. Courier service is provided on scheduled rounds to clinics and other areas on campus.
- 2. This service provides the pickup of specimens from clinics and the delivery of specimens to several lab sections on campus.
- 3. Courier rounds are an ever evolving schedule and change frequently.

- 4. Clinics are notified by courier when pick up times will be different than they would normally expect.
- 5. Routes are maintained by Central Processing staff in the absence of the courier if staffing levels permit.
