### **PROCEDURE GUIDELINES**

### A. Procedure

1. In accordance with the Department of Pathology overarching Proficiency Testing Procedure Section Handling and Analyzing: "This policy strictly prohibits referral or acceptance of proficiency testing specimens from other laboratories. This prohibition takes precedence over the requirement that proficiency testing specimens be handled in the same manner as patient specimens. It is the responsibility of every laboratory employee to understand that the referral (receiving or sending) of any proficiency samples while the testing event is still in progress (before the due date) is prohibited. In the event any employee should be asked to engage in such practice, they are required to immediately notify the CLIA Laboratory Director in charge of their lab and/or the WFBH Laboratory Compliance Officer."
