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## Auto-Dilution Verification Abbott Architect

#### I. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE:

To evaluate, at least annually, the accuracy of each instrument's auto-dilution function by comparing auto-diluted results to manually diluted results from each instrument.

#### II. PROCEDURE:

- A. Obtain a specimen that is near the AMR for a test that is auto-diluted on the analyzer.
- B. Run the sample 3 separate times using the standard volume.
- C. Run the sample 3 separate times using the onboard dilution.
- D. Manually dilute the sample using the same dilution factor as the onboard dilution.
- E. Run the manually diluted sample 3 separate times.
- F. Calculate the average value of the 3 replicates for the standard, onboard and manual dilutions.
- G. Calculate the percent difference. (Dilution Standard)/ Dilution x 100
- H. The percent difference must be with-in 10%.
- I. Results exceeding the acceptable criteria of 10% difference will be repeated. If repeat testing fails the acceptable criteria, the instrument will be serviced before continuing to test using the dilution function.
