  - **Provider**: tiers, network, pre-authorization



#### 3. Neonatal Band Numbers

- a. Please be advised that there is a stock issue with neonatal bands.
- b. Due to a back order/printing issue with the bands, we have been forced to utilize previously quarantined bands printed with only 4 digits.
- c. These bands are currently in use at Royal Oak and Troy.
- d. RO/Troy BB teams should not reject armbands with 4 digits.
- e. Neonatal specimens may be a mix of 4 digit and 5 digit bands dependent on the admission of the infant/length of stay.
- f. Phone calls to units to confirm band# should be performed if there is any doubt.

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### 5. Password Synchronization for East Team Members

- a. East team members must have their network password synchronized across the network **by Monday, May 6**.
- b. Anyone with an out of sync password should act now by using the Password Portal to reset their password.
- c. Impacted team members will begin receiving communications this month.
- d. Action Required:
  - i. Review the password creation rules before changing your password.
  - ii. Must be 12 or more characters.
  - iii. Must include three conditions of uppercase, lowercase, number, special characters.
  - iv. Cannot re-use your last 24 passwords nor any parts of previous passwords.
  - v. Do not include your name, nickname, username or ID, company name, 3 or more sequential.
  - vi. numbers or letters (such as abc or 123), department name, company terminology, or common words such as fall or 2024.
  - vii. Ensure you are enrolled in PingID MFA as the password portal tool uses multifactor authentication.
  - viii. Access the Password Self-Service Portal (www.corewellhealth.org/password).
  - ix. Select the Recover Password option, even if you know your password.
  - x. Create and confirm your new password.
  - xi. Lock and unlock your Corewell Health device (Windows key + L) using your new password.

- a. Go-Live Tuesday, February 13th.
- b. What gets reported to SafetyPause? Any team member related safety concern can be entered into SafetyPause.
- c. This includes both employed and non-employed team members for Corewell Health.
- d. Events that can be reported include Workplace Violence, employee injuries and exposures, and any other type of safety event that impacts our team.
