Change in *Helicobacter pylori* testing:

H. pylori fecal antigen test (HPSAG) will be replacing H. pylori IqG serology test; our reference lab is no longer offering this test

New Test Code:Epic Code LAB397 Sunquest SHPAG

H. pylori serologic testing is no longer recommended by the American Gasteroenterological Association, as it cannot distinguish between past and current infection. H. pylori fecal antigen test detects current infection and can be used as a test of cure.

Unity Point Health Peoria will now offer an in-house H. pylori fecal antigen test that is a lateral flow immunoassay with a sensitivity and specificity of >96% and 95%, respectively.

Acceptable specimens: fresh stool only

Unacceptable specimens: stool in preservative or Serum

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
