

LACTIC ACID HANDLING GUIDELINES

PRE-REQUISITES

- These requirements only pertain to Lactic Acid testing performed by the laboratory.
- Point of Care lactic acids performed on the EPOC are not subject to these requirements.
- Patient should be fasting and at complete rest and should not be clenching a fist. If the patient is not fasting please append a comment stating as much.

STEPS

- Release the tourniquet prior to popping the grey tube on for collection or don't use a tourniquet at all. Clenching the fist or the use of a tourniquet can increase the lactic acid levels.
- Immediately place the grey top on ice to chill. Please do not put the labeled tube directly on ice. See pictures for options as to keeping the tube dry but chilled.
- The tube can be placed in the finger of a glove and stuck into the ice or place ice into a biohazard bag and zip it shut, and then place the tube in paper sleeve in front of the bag.
- Specimen must be delivered to the lab within 10 minutes of being drawn, no later.
