Effective October 1st 2017, to maintain compliance with current guidelines and to correlate processes between Methodist and Proctor campuses, a patient that has had no transfusions or pregnancies within the last 3 months, the blood bank specimen can be drawn within 7 days prior to the date of surgery.

In summary:

Patient History	Time frame for drawing specimen
Transfusion or pregnancy within last 3 months (includes current pregnancy)	No more than 3 days pre-op. (no more than 2 is preferred)
No transfusions or pregnancies within last 3 months.	Within 7 days prior to pre-op date.
