OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION:	Pekin Lab will continue to do STAT CSF gram stains and STAT Surgical Specimen gram stains.  Strep Screens, Influenza A & B and RSV Testing will continue on the Pekin Campus		

It is important that our patient specimens for culture arrive in the laboratory prior to 19:00 to ensure better turnaround time for patient results.

We will be converting to plastic blood culture bottles, E-Swabs, and BD Affirm Swab collection for Vaginitis Panel. Please see the next page for collection devices.

Strep Screens need to be collected as a two swab collection: Single use Rayon swab for screening and E-Swab for culture if the screen is negative.

# Sterile Polyester Tipped Applicator

Rapid Strep testing only

Please Note: this is a one-time use swab. If confirmation Throat Culture is needed, additional collection of ESwab is required.



Score line to easily break off swab in



Cap = Flexible Minitip

- Aerobic cultures
- Throat cultures

- Aerobic and anaerobic cultures
- Superficial or Deep wounds

Uses Include:

- Pediatric or small site areas
- Nasopharyngeal Specimens

Once specimen is collected, place swab in media, break off at score line and recap specimen. Transport Room Temp





# CT/NG PCR Media Swab Kit (Cobas)— Female Only

Tube Looks Similar to Trichomonas BUT IS NOT the same specimen

- Vaginal use the woven vaginal swab, discard flock swab, Do Not Use Flock Swab for Vaginal Collection. Place Swab in Cobas PCR Media and send to lab.
- Endocervical Use the woven swab to remove excess mucus and collect the specimen with the flocked Endocervical swab. Place Endocervical Swab in Cobas PCR Media and send to lab
- Specimens submitted with 2 swabs or >10% bloody specimens will be rejected.





# CT/NG PCR Media Urine Kit (Cobas) – Unisex/Male

Tube Looks Similar to Trichomonas BUT IS NOT the same specimen

- Urine must be pipetted between the fill lines.
- Can be used on male or female patient.
- Specimens submitted below/above the fill line or >10% bloody specimens will be rejected.
