
## Effective Thursday October 3, 2019, the urinalysis with reflex to urine culture criteria will change to below:

Previous Criteria	New Criteria
Moderate or greater Leukocyte	
Esterase or Nitrite	
AND	
>10 WBCs	>10 WBCs

The SunQuest LIS system is not sophisticated enough to handle the appropriate rules we would like set up for UA reflex to culture so we have to adjust our reflex testing to only include WBCs. Please reflex the UA to culture if there are >10WBCs for Emergency Room patients at Pekin. NOTE: Sunquest will automatically order the Emergency Room culture when >10 WBC's are reported in the Microscopic.

You will see this screen when reviewing the results. If a culture has already been ordered, then one should be cancelled as a duplicate. Make certain the label on the tube is the open order not the cancelled order.

Please make certain that the tube label has the UMACRO and UMICRO crossed off to avoid confusion.



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
