

## Bench Cleaning

At the end of each shift, each bench should be cleaned and restocked by the person that worked on that bench.

Cleaning & Restocking Responsibilities
1. Disinfect bench.
2. Replace benchtop biohazard bag with a new one.
3. Clean oil off 100x objective and microscope stage.
4. Restock pipettes, wooden applicators, slides, coverslips, loops, etc.
5. Roll biohazard bin to the front of the lab.

When finished with your own bench work, use this list to check other areas for work prior to leaving low census.
