PROCEDURE: URINALYSIS PATHOLOGIST REVIEW

POLICY:

Refer specimen to the pathologist when the following are present upon sedimentation examination:

- 1. Tyrosine and/or leucine crystals
- 2. Crystals suspicious for cystine
- 3. Presence of sperm in a young female specimen , under the age of puberty

PROCEDURE:

If the pathologist is available, take the specimen to be evaluated immediately.

If the pathologist is not available have a second technologist review the slide and enter a comment "Slide reviewed and results confirmed by [tech] [time] [date]. Pathologist review pending." If a second technologist is not available enter the comment "Pathologist review pending." Place the urine in the pathology refrigerator with a copy of the report and place a copy of the report with a note to the pathologist to analyze the urine sediment in the pathology Department.
