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TOPIC/QUESTION:

I'm giving a patient an orange top container to take home because they can't produce a sample right now, what do I order?

ANSWER/TIP:

When giving sample collection containers to patients to take home, we should **not** order the test requested, but order a KIT test code (KIT1, KIT2, KIT3). We have the ability to order up to 3 KITs to record what sample containers were given to a patient.

KIT1=1 container given

KIT2= 2 containers given

KIT3= 3 containers given

- You can use the keypad to select your option, or close the keypad and free-text the container/test if not in the keypad. Label the container(s) with the LIS labels and give to the patient.
- Test codes report to iEHR and EMR to ensure that the ordering practitioner is notified that the patient went to the lab for the specified tests and were given collection kits

When patient comes back → type in the order number of the KIT → ADD NEXT ORDER to generate a new order number for the pending test/s
