Sputum/ETT	Significant growth from sputum/ETT specimens where previous specimens, in same visit, were negative.	No	Yes
Blood Cultures	> Positive cultures, not contaminants.	No	Yes
C.diff testing	> Positive and indeterminate results.	Yes	Yes
MRSA	> Positive results.	Yes	Yes
VRE	> Positive results.	Yes	Yes
ESBL	> Positive results.	Yes	Yes
CPE	> Preliminarily positive results.	Yes	Yes
RSV	> Positive results only.	Yes	Yes
