## **Ethics and Decision Making**

- An ethical decision involves making decisions regarding right and wrong behavior.
- When individual are required to face a difficult decision, necessary steps and factors must be taken into consideration to ensure all parties involved will come to the best possible solution.

#### **Difficult choices in Health Care**

Ask yourself these questions when faced with a difficult decision in health care:

- 1. "What is the right thing to do?"
- 2. "how should this decision be made?"
- 3. "Is this a reasonable compromise?"

All decisions need to ensure the NTHSSA Vision is supported and the NTHSSA Values are reflected.

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# **Ethical Decision-Making Process Quick Reference**

Step  $1 \rightarrow$  Identify the facts.

Step  $2 \rightarrow$  Identify the cultural traditions or beliefs that impact the ethical issue.

Step 3 → Specify feasible alternative solutions or courses of action.

Step 4 → Use resources to identify significant factors in each alternative.

Step  $5 \rightarrow$  Propose and test possible solutions.

Step 6 → Make your choice, act, and evaluate.
