

Laboratory Staff Meeting Minutes

- 1. Saline gargle samples for COVID:
- Laura S has validated this sample type for both the GX and BF
- It is for COVID testing only, not Flu or RSV
- Not sure when we will be receiving these samples
- This source is built in the LIS and is ready to be used if we get one

2. Staffing:

- There are 2 positions for technologists open currently. Laura is working with HR to find candidates but it is very difficult to get MLT at this time

- Not sure exactly what is happening with the MLA in micro but there is a plan in place and should be resolved soon

- Myles is leaving at the end of August. Phoenix will be staying until at least the end of December. She will report to Laura S but will continue to sit in the main lab as there is more she can help them with. But her priority is COVID testing

3. Phone problems:

We should not normally have to worry about this but if it does occur we need to contact Inuvik to let them know the negative bottle hasn't been resulted.
