

NWT LIS TIP OF THE WEEK

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TOPIC/QUESTION:

Why can't I find the doctor I'm looking for when accessioning? Why don't the last three letters of the practitioner's last name in the code field always pull up the entry I need anymore?

ANSWER/TIP:

After approximately 8 years using SoftLab we can no longer consistently use the first three letters of the practitioner's last name when setting up new practitioners as we now have too many entries not to cause overlap. Moving forward, when assigning a LIS practitioner code for a practitioner that has the same first three letters of the last name as another practitioner, our only option is to assign a number code to them. This means that searching by name will always be more reliable than searching by code.

EXAMPLE: Practitioner: **Dr. Macdonald, Joseph Gerard**
