## ANSWER/TIP:

### LIS Servers and Applications

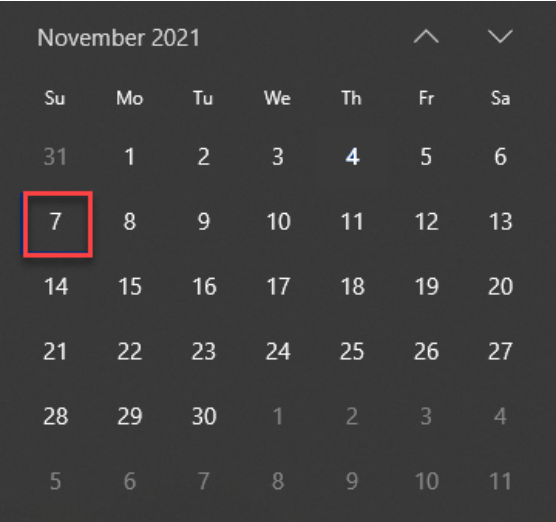
The system will automatically change to the correct time. This is a standard part of the Operating System.

### PC Workstations

The PC will change automatically, you may see a pop-up in the bottom corner if you are logged on or the first time you log into a computer after the time changes.

### Print Scheduler

Jobs that usually run between 2:00AM and 2:59AM will **not** run. Any jobs missed during that time will print at the end of the day on November 7<sup>th</sup>.
