TOPIC/QUESTION:

On Sunday, March 13th we will set our clocks forward one hour as daylight saving time begins.

ANSWER/TIP:

LIS Servers and Applications

The system will automatically change to the correct time. This is a standard part of the Operating System.

PC Workstations

The PC will change automatically, you may see a pop-up in the bottom corner if you are logged on or the first time you log into a computer after the time changes.

Print Scheduler

Jobs that usually run between 2:00AM and 2:59AM will **not** run.

Any jobs missed during that time will print at the end of the day on March 13.

one hour

Timestamps

Some issues with collection and verification times cannot be avoided. The timestamps are generated with the current system time. A comment can always be attached to those orders collected or verified around the time change to avoid later confusion.
