

Microbiology Meeting Minutes

June 15, 2022 12:15 to 13:00

1. Bench duties and checklists:

- Laura S has changed the bench duties again to reflect the return of the 12 to 8 shift
- Some duties have been transferred to the front bench
- Please ensure you check your assigned bench duties and use your checklists
- There is now a checklist for the front bench and the evening shift. Both are on the same page and are at the front bench

2. Future plans for the department:

- Veronica will be returning soon, and Laura S will be hopefully hiring 2 new technologists for a 1-year term
- There will be a lot of people in the department but that is good because we know how quickly things can change
- Laura S plans on having a tech on the front bench when Phoenix is gone and may develop a genital bench and bring back all these specimens.

3. Evacuation map:

- During an accreditation exercise, Moses and Laura were asked where the evacuation maps were
- Laura S wanted to make sure everyone knows there is one on each door leaving the lab (blood bank and core lab)

4. Fire extinguisher and pull station:

- They also asked where the nearest fire pull station was. It is in the core lab, beside the chemistry fridge across from hematology

- The lab does not maintain these, it is done by Dexterra if they ask

5. Cefazolin KB:

- Laura S wanted to remind everyone that for GNB (except Pseudomonas) in non-urine samples need to have Cefazolin KB done
- Make sure to remember this and it is in the ASTM

6. SCOV2:

- If only COVID is ordered, order PCCOV
- SCOV2 will send the whole panel across



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7. QC labels:

- The labels will change due to a new QC bug ordered for the new VRE plates
- Laura S will let everyone know when this happens
- The slants will change, and the weekly plate labels will change

8. Frozen QC bugs:

- The map will be updated
- Some bugs don't freeze well, and we don't use them very often. There will just be sticks in the fridge that can be subbed out when needed
