- 1. What to do when bacteria in gram is not on plates:
 - Laura S has made new comments to help with this and put them on the STGM keypads
 - Laura S has created a flow chart on how to handle this situation.
 - We always want to make sure our gram and culture match but sometimes it is difficult due to overgrowth of other bacteria
 - Laura S has attached the flowchart to the end of these minutes and will also print off a copy and place on the specimen fridge
- 2. Reading QC plates and Vitek QC on Thursdays:
 - Laura S wasn't sure if this is getting hard for the urine bench tech to do
 - Everyone thinks it is ok, so this will stay like this

3. Laura S off:

- There will be different people acting for her
- If there are issues, go to the acting person and they can escalate the problem if needed
- Chelsea will be doing some acting as she has learned how to do the inventory for the department and this will give her a chance to work on this
- 4. Ask for help when needed:

7. Trichomonas validation:

- We have 20 positives and are working on 20 negatives
- We have done the reproducibility with the QC
- We will continue to run a few more positives just in case DL wants more
- This new test will be a great addition to the micro lab

8. BioFire BCID pouches:

- Laura S has ordered more the BioFire blood culture ID tests
- We cannot report results based on these
- We can use them if we are uncertain of the gram in a positive blood culture
- They are very expensive so try to only use if needed

9. Roundtable:

Solomon: Had a negative WP that he ran the new trich test on and it was positive. The swab was 2 days old. Laura S explained that the new trich test detects Trichomonas antigens. These antigens are present even after the organism has died. This is a good example of why this test is better than wetprep especially since a lot of our specimens are on the older side
