# LIS Servers and Applications


The system will automatically change to the correct time. This is a standard part of the Operating System.

#### **PC Workstations**

The PC will change automatically, you may see a pop-up in the bottom corner if you are logged on or the first time you log into a computer after the time changes.

#### **Print Scheduler**

Jobs that run between 1:00AM and 1:59AM will run twice. This is not a problem if the job finishes and flags the records before the job starts again. Jobs that do not finish before being restarted may print twice.



### **Timestamps**

Some issues with collection and verification times cannot be avoided. The timestamps are generated with the current system time. A comment can always be attached to those orders collected or verified around the time change to avoid later confusion.
