

Microbiology Meeting Minutes

- 1. S.pneumo on new VITEK AST card:
 - Penicillin is called benzylpenicillin on card. They are the same thing
 - There is penicillin-pneumonia: This does not apply to us, so ignore this
 - Penicillin-meningitis and penicillin-oral are what they are. Penicillin-other is penicillin-non meningitis
 - Laura S cannot change these on the card
- 2. SOP for micro:
 - All procedures are supposed to be approved by NTHSSA policy department and placed on our NTHSSA
 - It has been requested that this happens with micro SOP
 - Laura S is in the process of doing this. Once approved, they will be reprinted and placed in binders, uploaded to the shared drive and will be on ourNTHSSA

- 3. Micro workload and staffing:
 - The lab forced growth application that would give micro 7 technologists and the core lab extra staff was denied
 - This means that micro will still have its 5 technologists and 1 supervisor
 - We currently have 6 staff members to fill in for upcoming retirements but as soon as 1 technologist leaves, they will not be replaced
 - We will need to rearrange our bench set up and need to give up some work
 - As previously discussed, BV, Trich, genital cultures and throats will be the first things to go
 - Then we may look at not doing YPCC samples
 - We have time to do this which is a positive thing so we can decide what we can do
 - Will only have 2 people on Saturday so this will be our biggest area of change
 - Micro has done such an amazing job of proving what we can do with 6 technologists so I think it will be felt when we start sending stuff out
- 4. CRE and CRO:
 - CRE is carbapenem resistant Enterobacterales
 - CRO is carbapenem resistant organism
 - OCPHO has asked questions about this because we had a PA that was resistant to meropenem, and we copied it to them
 - The OCPHO reportable sheet does only say CRE, but they are going to change that to CRO as it is something they should know about
