- ➤ KPI's- I just finished my quarterly KPI's in which one of the indicators I look at is Turn around times (TAT's). Some of numbers did not look good, so to compare of the % of testing that was above the 55 minute mark between the last 2 quarters looks like this:
  - o CBC- 1.96% to 5.12%
  - Lytes- 3.77% to 2.90%
  - INR- 6.76% to 13.35%
  - Troponin- 9.17% to 7.37%

We had a couple go down some but the CBC's and INR's had some big increases. I am suspecting the INR's may be linked to the fact that the LIS is still not working, and people are forgetting about them. Because we are entering them manually, we have to be extra aware to make sure we are getting the STATs out within the 55 minutes. For the CBC's please make sure you are also trying to get those Diffs and morphs out within the 55mins.

- Transfusion-
