- 1. Naming instruments:
 - Needs to be agreed on by everyone and if someone doesn't like a name, we won't use it
- 2. ASTM:
 - Just want to make sure everyone realized when using the ASTM, the susceptibility reporting table at the beginning lists what drugs need to be reported based on the sample or other drug results. The other flow charts or beta lactam tables list how the results for the drugs that are going to be reported based on the first table. We do not add all the drugs that are in these flowcharts, they are just for interpretation
- 3. Vacation time:

 - Further discussion found that it would be best if we referred out BV and genital cultures except Gonorrhoeae Culture. This is so there is time in

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
