Specimen	Results to be reported
Gram stain	 Stains from: deep wounds, blood cultures, sterile fluids, CSF positive for: Gram positive cocci in pairs or pairs and chains Gram positive cocci suggestive of Streptococci
Wound	 Significant growth from surgical site, post-operative and orthopedic specimens
Blood Culture	> Positive culture results excluding contaminants
Body Fluid Culture	> Positive culture results
CSF Culture	> Positive culture results
C. difficile Toxin	> Positive results
MRSA	> Positive culture results
VRE	> Positive culture results
ESBL	> Positive culture results
CRE/CPO	> Preliminary positive culture results
SARS-CoV-2	> Positive results
Influenza A and B	> Positive results
RSV	> Positive results
МТВ	> Positive results
Streptococcus agalatiae	Positive culture results from: blood cultures, sterile fluids, CSF in neonates
Streptococcus pyogenes	> Positive culture results from: blood cultures, sterile fluids, CSF
Haemophilus influenzae	> Positive culture results from: blood cultures, sterile fluids, CSF
Any disease/organism on Schedule 3: Reportable Diseases	> Any source or site

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
