1. Genital cultures:

- How is this going? Everyone said it is going well
- Has it made things easier and better? Yes, it is making the workload better

2. QC changes:

- No MCAT QC
- No ALA QC
- TXP will use GAS not S. salivarius as negative
- This all means that there is no more
 - > M. cat QC organism
 - > A. aph QC organism
 - > S. salivarius QC organism
- Laura S needs to change the QC checklist

3. QC labels:

- Weekly CO2 now include yeast and don't include ones above
- Weekly BA slant are different organisms (S. epi, ENT and Streps)
- Weekly NUT slants are different organisms (SA, ENT, KPN and PA)
- Weekly QC plate labels are changed but didn't throw out ones already printed. Just removed ALA label and changed S. salivarius to GAS
- Monthly CO2 now is included for Tuesday after bead sub

4. CPO Screens:

- Remember these swabs will start coming this month
- It should be on an APL microbiology requisition with CPO screen written on
- We will order the test MRCPO and put the swab in the "to be task listed" bucket
- Make sure to collect and receive the specimen and add any important information if on the requisition in the pop up boxes
- Jen asked if we need to add copy to SLAB. Laura S has confirmed that yes, we need to add a copy to SLAB so the report prints



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5. Yeast culture/Oral Culture

- Now that we are using chromogenic plates, we will be screening for Candida species and not just C. albicans
- I have changed the organism ystnot to say Yeast not Candida species
- I will change the yeast ID SOP

6. Cat B boxes:

- When we send a sample to NML, it needs to go in the plastic bag, the paper bag and then that in the box
- This is the same for swabs going to APL. They need to have all 3
- There should always be the same number of each piece (box, white bag and plastic bag)
- This is correct Cat B shipping
- Asked if we can order white envelopes separately. Laura S will look into this
- Asked if it needs to be packaged this way for APL and Laura S confirmed with Carolyn that it does since it is a pure culture

7. HPV testing:

- This will be starting soon
- They will be using our requisition and will be writing HPV on the clinical information portion or maybe somewhere else. We will know its HPV due to the swab
- We will Medipatient if needed and will order the test REHPV in the LIS
- Will go on the REFERRAL HPV worklist
- We will package the swabs in a box, use the address labels made and need to add Exempt Human Specimens sticker
- We will use FedEx and fill out a waybill as per the template
- Put the box and the waybill on the front counter just like NML
- The reports will be faxed to the blood bank fax
- When we get them, we are going to transcribe them in the LIS
- There are keypads for the different types of results (go over them and the reports)
- We discussed a log sheet or keeping track of samples sent. Laura S will create a binder like with NML where we will keep copies of everything sent and when we get the results back, we will reconcile it with the binder reports
