- Checking Lots- Please ensure you are checking tat you are taking up the appropriate lot of reagent/QC when getting new ones. It was brought to my attention that people noticed this was not happening and when I was doing the Ortho Inventory, I saw we had 3 boxes left of the new Lot, but someone opened a box from the new lot and took it from there.
