- **Coroner/Warrant Samples-** POCT Fridge has 2 containers one labeled for each type of sample. For Coroner requests, if you are waiting for paperwork from them place samples in there until it is received, then they go into box for APL (no LIS entry). For warrants, make a copy of the warrant, record name and phone number of officer presenting the warrant. Advise office the samples will be put aside until we are authorized to release them. Warrant goes to supervisor or most responsible person who submits to Quality Risk. Via SFT. They will advise us when samples can be released.
- **Hand Hygiene Audits-** In the past I have taken care of doing these, but I will be asking staff to take part in the monthly audits. You can scan the QR code to log a Hand Hygiene moment- make sure to put "Core" in the comment sections. Each part of the lab is responsible for 10 audits/month each. We can keep track on the board, so we know when we hit moments.
