2. Welcome to Tessa, Good bye to Isaiah 😞
3. Issuing 2 units at a time – Policy is to only issue 1 unit of blood at a time usually. However there are exceptions to this to units which have rapid infusers such as ER and the OR. For these locations when a patient is bleeding they can hang and infuse 2 units at a time so if requested for those locations go ahead and issue multiple units together. For a bleeding patient turn around time on those units can be very quick – they can infuse a unit in a couple of minutes.
4. Fibrinogen -RiaStap – coagulation testing – reminder that if Fibrinogen concentrate is requested we do require Fibrinogen testing to be ordered. You can issue the fibrinogen before the test is resultd but it should be drawn before the product is transfused. Always remember that we can consult with the TM physician if you are feeling that the orders for any product should be discussed with the TM physician. You can also remind for testing to be ordered such as Fibrinogens, coagulation testing or repeat CBCs. To ensure products are being ordered and transfused appropriately for patient condition.
