Subject: Automatic Addition of Throat Culture to Strep Group A Antigen (Quick Strep)

Test Name:	Strep Group A Antigen (Quick Strep)
Test Codes:	QSTRP (Quick Strep) XTC (Throat Culture)
Test Change: Automatic addition of Throat Culture	 When the Quick Strep (QSTRP) test is ordered in Cerner, the following will occur: When QSTRP is ordered on a patient in the Emergency Department, a Throat Culture (XTC) will be automatically ordered via Cerner and both orders will transmit to Sunquest simultaneously. When QSTRP is ordered on a patient outside the ED, then A Throat Culture (XTC) is automatically ordered via Cerner and marked in Cerner as "Ordered/completed." The XTC order will automatically transmit to Sunquest. The Quick Strep (QSTRP) will be in an "Ordered/pending collection" status. Once Nursing has collected and marked task as "completed," the order then transmits to Sunquest.
Receiving in the LIS	 The QSTRP and XTC will be on different accession numbers (this WILL NOT change). When receiving the QSTRP, YOU MUST look for a throat culture order. Both tests MUST be received in the LIS simultaneously.
Specimen Source	Throat
Specimen Collection	 Nursing MUST send a dual swab for testing which is obtained from Hospital Materials Management. The extraction for the rapid strep will kill any organisms so a separate swab is required for culture.
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
