## Date: August 26, 2015 LABORATORY ALERT Mandatory Flu Vaccine

Effective Date:	Friday, Sept. 25 – Monday, Nov. 23 before 2 p.m <b>100 % compliance required</b>
Condition of Employment	Failure to comply with mandatory flu policy will result in immediate termination at 4 p.m. Nov 23rd. <i>Managers are responsible for enforcing policy</i> .
Obtaining Vaccination	Adventist HealthCare will provide free flu vaccines at all of the entities.
Information	Staff will receive reminders of upcoming flu vaccine clinic dates as they are shared. Look for posted Flyers
Exception Reminders	<ul> <li>Employees <u>must submit a signed exemption form each year.</u></li> <li>AHC has secured egg-free vaccines, so egg related exemptions will <u>not</u> be accepted.</li> <li>For valid exemption, a <b>face mask must be properly worn over the mouth and nose daily,</b> except during meals, during a timeframe to be determined by AHC.</li> </ul>
Responsibility	<ul> <li>It is employee's responsibility to meet requirement and deadline.</li> <li>It is the supervisor's responsibility to monitor staff compliance to AHC's mandatory flu vaccine policy, including mask-wearing for those with a valid exemption.</li> </ul>
Monitoring Compliance	<ul> <li>Employees must obtain a copy of Flu vaccine sheet they sign AND</li> <li>Provide a copy of signed documentation to Lab Dept. Admin Assistant for employee personal file and tracking.</li> </ul>
Compliance	<ul><li>Employee compliance is determined by:</li><li>Copy of signed Flu Vaccination document in employee file.</li></ul>
Prevent FLU	<ul><li>Frequent hand washing before and after patient care</li><li>Stay home if you have influenza-like illness</li></ul>
