<b>Specimen Requirements:</b>	PST - Lithium Heparin plasma (mint green top tube) Refrigerate
<b>Transport to SGMC and Turn Around Time:</b>	<b>Transport:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do <b>NOT</b> hold or batch Timed, ASAP or STAT specimens.</li><li>• STAT/ASAP and Timed specimens will be immediately couriered to SGMC as they are received.</li><li>• Send specimens refrigerated to SGMC.</li></ul> <b>TAT:</b> 4 hours
