Specimen Requirements:	PST - Lithium Heparin plasma (mint green top tube) Refrigerate
Transport to SGMC and Turn Around Time:	 Transport: Do NOT hold or batch Timed, ASAP or STAT specimens. STAT/ASAP and Timed specimens will be immediately couriered to SGMC as they are received. Send specimens refrigerated to SGMC.
	TAT: 4 hours

	Aliquot label: Will have "PS SG" to indicate testing is performed at SGMC.
