**Stat Notification Log** 

## **Description of change(s):**

In an effort to ensure phlebotomy collects all STAT/ASAP test orders on time,

- 1. STAT/ASAP labels print in processing.
- 2. Processing staff will be expected to notify the phlebotomist via vocera when a STAT/ASAP label prints.
  - a. We have provided a timer to each location to help remind processors to look at the printer.
  - b. The timer will be set to go off after 15 minutes. The person responding to the timer will press the button twice to stop and restart the timer for another 15 minute interval.
- 3. Processing staff members will document the call on the "Stat Notification" Loa."
  - a. Place one aliquot (footer) label for the patient on the form. It is not necessary to document each accession as long as the patient id documented.
  - b. Write the name of the person notified and the time notified.
  - c. Place your tech code in the "Notified By" box.

We will track missed stat orders and verify that the phlebotomist was notified.
