Hand Hygiene Review

Description:

Policy: As stated in the *Bloodborne Pathogens Exposure Control Plan* -

 Employees must wash their hands using an effective antimicrobial method (e.g. with antimicrobial soap or an antiseptic hand cleaner) every time gloves are changed or when leaving the laboratory.

Procedure: The *Venipuncture* states to wash your hands prior to donning gloves and at the end of the collection when you remove your gloves.

Expectation: You must follow the SOP and policy EVERY TIME

We use the word 'lavender' to remind others but not draw negative attention.
