Process:	The DI rule for HLK on Potassium is changing June 1, 2021
	The new process is as follows:
	<ol> <li>When the Potassium results as HLK, the HLK will hold and "CBACK-;" will appear in the test comment column. When this occurs:</li> </ol>
	<ul> <li>Technical staff will call the unit to inform them that the potassium cannot be reported due to hemolysis.</li> <li>Technical staff will also inform the person taking the call that it is up to the physician to determine if the potassium needs to be reordered.</li> <li>Document the call in DI.</li> </ul>
	2. DI will no longer hold all the tests on an HLK sample. The remaining results, if normal, will auto release.
