- 2. Three pink tubes will be collected in case we have to refer the sample to the ARC Reference Lab.

1. PURPOSE

To define the process for ordering a T&S on an outpatient that is referred to the Infusion Center for transfusion for the first time.

2. SCOPE

All blood bank staff members will be aware of the information provided in an OICTS order.

3. RESPONSIBILITY

All blood bank staff members must follow this procedure when performing testing on an OICTS order.

4. **DEFINITIONS**

OICTS—A type and screen order that is intended to be used for patients being referred to the Outpatient Infusion Center for the first time. A type and screen will be performed. The order includes additional information fields that will provide blood bank with the information necessary to perform antibody identification on a patient that is not in the hospital. The order will also include additional specimen so the workup can be completed without recalling the patient.

5. PROCEDURE

Step	Action				
1	The ordering provider will be asked to provide the following information the first time an outpatient is referred to the infusion center for transfusion. This information will be documented on the Outpatient Transfusion Orders Form (70 171) at the time the order is submitted. A. Transfusion history B. Pregnancy history C. RhIG history D. Hospitalization history				
2	Outpatient Infusion staff members will place the OICTS order into Cerner and answer the history prompts. This will facilitate transfer of the information to blood bank staff and eliminate the need to hold antibody workups until the provider can be reached. **Total Control Provided Control Pr				
3	Three pink tubes will be collected with this order. One of the tubes will contain BB/TS armbanding system. The extra tubes will be used for antibody identificat and reference lab referral as needed. This will prevent recalling the patient for additional sample.
