DESCRIPTION OF PROCEDURE REVISION

Name of procedure:

Outpatient Infusion Type & Screen (OICTS) Order

Description of change(s):

We have a new order that will be used for patients being referred to the OIC for transfusion for the first time. The test is "OICTS" for Outpatient Infusion T&S.

1. This test will have the patient's transfusion, RhIG, and hospitalization history listed in the order.
2. Three pink tubes will be collected in case we have to refer the sample to the ARC Reference Lab.

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1. **PURPOSE**
 To define the process for ordering a T&S on an outpatient that is referred to the Infusion Center for transfusion for the first time.


 2. **SCOPE**
 All blood bank staff members will be aware of the information provided in an OICTS order.

 3. **RESPONSIBILITY**
 All blood bank staff members must follow this procedure when performing testing on an OICTS order.

4. DEFINITIONS

OICTS—A type and screen order that is intended to be used for patients being referred to the Outpatient Infusion Center for the first time. A type and screen will be performed. The order includes additional information fields that will provide blood bank with the information necessary to perform antibody identification on a patient that is not in the hospital. The order will also include additional specimen so the workup can be completed without recalling the patient.

5. PROCEDURE

1	<p>The ordering provider will be asked to provide the following information the first time an outpatient is referred to the infusion center for transfusion. This information will be documented on the Outpatient Transfusion Orders Form (7030-171) at the time the order is submitted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Transfusion history B. Pregnancy history C. RhIG history D. Hospitalization history 																														
2	<p>Outpatient Infusion staff members will place the OICTS order into Cerner and answer the history prompts.
