PURPOSE

This flowchart is used to help the collector make decisions about whether to proceed with a collection. Additionally, the flowchart directs the collector to various Work Instructions for problem collections.

Step 1 (3, 10)

Donor ID Problems

YES

Do not collect. If ID is determined, document ID method under REMARKS on COC

NO

Step 1 (11)

BAT Ordered or Requested

YES

Do BAT before Urine Drug Collection.

NO

Step 1 (13)

Items found that may or are definitely used for tampering

YES

Hold material until after collection. Document findings under REMARKS on COC

NO

Step 1 (14)

Offer Split collection kit only if employer requested

YES

Use SINGLE kit unless SPLIT is requested by employer

NO

Step 1 (14)

Less than 30 mL collected

YES

Follow SHY BLADDER protocol

NO

Step 1 (15)

Urine looks adulterated, i.e., blue, foams, chlorox smell

YES

Do 2nd Collection but NOT observed (unless company requests)

NO

Step 2 (1)

Urine Temp out of range (90-100)

YES

Do 2nd Collection but NOT observed (unless company requests)

NO

Step 2 (3)

Unusual events during collection

YES

Document under REMARKS of COC
