





STANDARDIZED TESTING / OPERATING PROTOCOL REQUEST/ANNOUNCEMENT

Leuko EZ Vue (LACFEC) Testing at ARMC

Description:	In-House Testing will change from Stool, WBC (stain) to new Lactoferrin test – Leuko EZ Vue. All Cone Health sites will send LACFEC testing to Alamance.

Staff Update:	<p>Alamance: Leuko EZ Vue test will replace the current method of staining stool for WBC. Staff trained and competent will change to the Leuko EZ Vue method and stop reading WBC on stained smear.</p> <p>Annie Penn, MedCenter, Wesley Long, and Women’s: All LACFEC will be batched via SMART to MC for transfer via courier to ARMC.</p> <p>Moses Cone: All LACFEC will be batched via SMART to ARMC and sent to Moses Cone on regular courier schedule.</p>

The Alamance Regional Cone Health Hospital Clinical Laboratory will convert to the Leuko EZ Vue assay on January 9, 2018 to detect Fecal Lactoferrin. This new assay will replace the existing test method for Fecal WBC testing performed by Giemsa stain and microscopic review.

Lactoferrin is highly stable and reduces the risk of false negatives due to cell breakdown over the microscopic method.

On site testing will be provided for all Cone Health hospital locations at Alamance Regional. Greensboro and Reidsville will no longer send Fecal Lactoferrin specimens to LabCorp.
